



Reopening of Jamia Masjid and Islamic Centre (JMIC)

From the 15th June 2020, the government has started to relax the rules which allows places of worship to reopen for *individual worship only*. **Please note: The Mosque will not be reopening on this date.**

We are making the necessary changes in order to reopen for congregational prayers from the 1st week of July, subject to further confirmation. We expect the Government and Public Health Authority to provide guidance on the maximum number of people allowed in the Mosque and how we can open with minimal risk to our congregation and also the wider community.

We will be introducing new controls, processes and procedures to minimize the risk of cross contamination amongst the congregation. This means there will be noticeable changes to the way the congregation will enter and exit the building, as well as additional safety procedures put in place. Full details will be published in near future Insha'Allah.

We will continue our online teaching and other programs.

This is a very challenging time for all of us. We pray Allah SWT opens the doors of His Mercy and allow us to congregate in the Houses of Allah with good health, peace and aafiyah. Aameen
