## CORONA VIRUS – TEMPORARY CLOSURE

From March 19, 2020



*After discussion and guidance from health professionals and our ulama, JMIC will be temporarily SUSPENDING all congregational activities from \*TONIGHT (18 March 2020) after the Isha prayer. \**

The developing situation with the COVID19 pandemic and the risk it presents all in our community (the elderly, vulnerable, children & those who unknowingly could pass on the virus) means we felt this is the best course of action.

### This means:

- No congregational daily prayers
- No Jumm'ah (Friday) prayer
- No social gatherings
- No classes & activities

*This policy will remain in effect until such time guidance is established that it is safe to resume.*

We will continue consulting experts, our Imams and scholars with regards to when we resume operations and will review the situation on a daily basis. We know every believer has a deep affiliation to the Masjid, however we do not want to take the risk of this virus spreading and harming people in our community.

This is a time of introspection, remembrance and calling upon our Creator.

We kindly request you all to fervently call upon Allah to alleviate our troubles, remove all sicknesses, allow us to take heed of the many lessons of tribulation and bring us closer to Him.
